Last big jobs set for 1000-yd High Power Range

High Power is final project in COSSA Range masterplan designed by engineer Bill Lewis

We are now entering the final phases of construction on the 1000-yd. High Power Range. The work schedule calls for casting a cement base for the metal target holders, fabricating the holders and installing them, and then building the wooden target frames. The final work will consist of laying the communications system between the pit, firing lines and range office, and marking the individual firing points on firing lines.

Perhaps many of our newer members are unaware that the High Power Range has been part of the COSSA development plan from the beginning of the range. Also, that the High Power Range has been designed and laid out by COSSA Member-at-Large and chief engineer, Bill Lewis. Bill was actively involved in COSSA's search for a suitable range site and participated in negotiations with the BLM. He surveyed and laid out the range as it exists today. Not only is Bill a seasoned engineer, but a gunsmith and long time competition shooter and reloader. Along with a number of other dedicated members, Bill has worked tirelessly to complete the COSSA range master plan. When the High Power Range is ready for its first match next spring that mission will have been accomplished.

Prior to the first match we will hold a series of orientation classes to instruct long range shooters in range procedures. All interested shooters should attend.

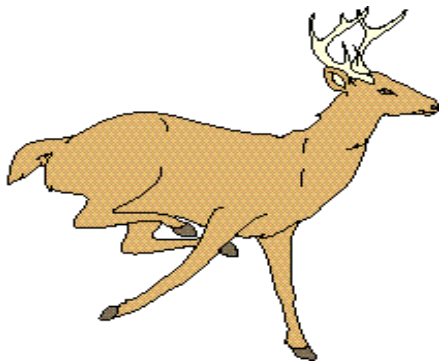

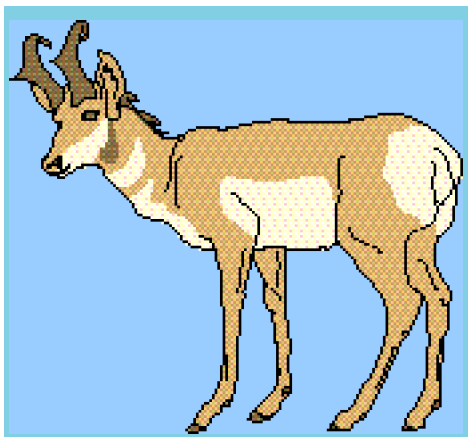
